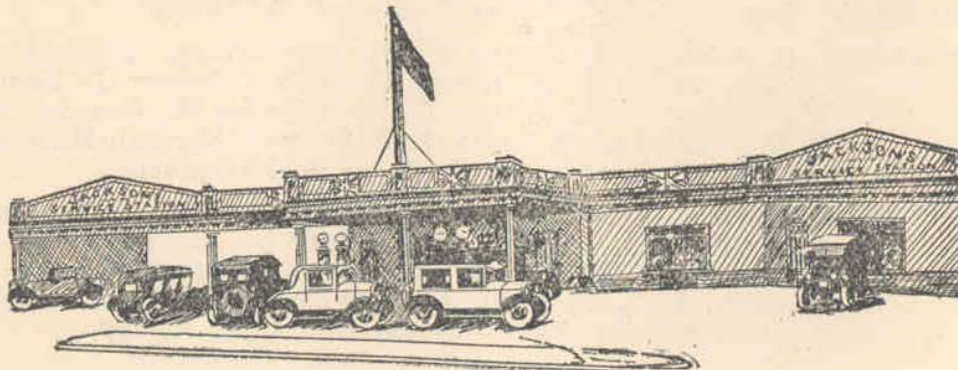

Definition of Amateur

It shall consist of Clubs which adopt the definition of an Amateur, viz.: to be "one who has not entered into an open competition; or for either a stake, public or admission money, or entrance fee; or competed with or against a professional for any prize; who has never taught, pursued or assisted in the pursuit of athletic exercises as a means of livelihood*; whose membership of any rowing or other athletic Club was not brought about, or does not continue, because of any mutual agreement or understanding, expressed or implied, whereby his becoming or continuing a member of such Club would be of any pecuniary benefit to him whatever, direct or indirect, who has never been employed in any occupation involving any use of the oar or paddle, who rows for pleasure or recreation only, and during his leisure hours, and who does not abandon or neglect his usual business or occupation for the purpose of training for more than two weeks during a rowing season,** and who has never pawned or sold any medal or trophy won by him in any aquatic or athletic contest, and who has never entered in any such contest under a name other than his own."

*This clause is intended especially to prevent any so-called Amateur Oarsmen being surreptitiously compensated for rowing, as for instance, by being furnished lucrative employment in sinecure positions.

**The Executive Committee of the Association have decided that the last rule of this definition does not apply to time taken up by contestants in travelling to and from regattas.

Classification of Oarsmen

A junior oarsman is one who has never won a race.

A junior sculler is one who has never won a race.

No oarsman or sculler who has won an open senior or intermediate race shall be allowed to compete in any of the 140 pound classes.

These rules may be varied to permit a junior oarsman or sculler to compete throughout the continuance of any Regatta as a junior in as many separate events as such contestant may have been properly entered. Winners to qualify for next highest race at the regatta.

These definitions apply to shell boats only, except that the winning of a race for crews no member of which shall be of greater weight than 140 lbs., or 150 lbs., shall, however, only qualify an oarsman in that particular class. Races in working boats (which term includes all boats except shell boats) will not affect the status of any oarsman or sculler as a junior. Competitions in shell boats with members of his own club, or in private matches (a private match being understood to consist of an invitation competition between representatives of not more than four clubs) will not affect the standing of a junior oarsman or sculler.

Eight-oared shells, Special (for contestants who shall not weigh more than 140 pounds, weight at water-side—and who have never won an intermediate or senior sweep-oared race).

Eight-oared shells, Senior.

Eight-oared shells, Junior.

At the discretion of the Regatta Committee a Consolation eight-oared race for losing contestants of the junior eights may be added to the programme. This race shall not qualify the contestants as to class.

The Umpire will start the races promptly.

The start will be made by gunshot after the warning, "Get Ready."

Any boat not at its post at the time specified shall be liable to be disqualified by the Umpire.

If the Umpire considers the start a false one, he shall at once recall the boats to their stations by gunshot from the Umpire's boat, and any boat refusing to start again shall be disqualified.

Coaching or any instruction given by any spectator may subject the contestant or crew to disqualification by the Umpire.

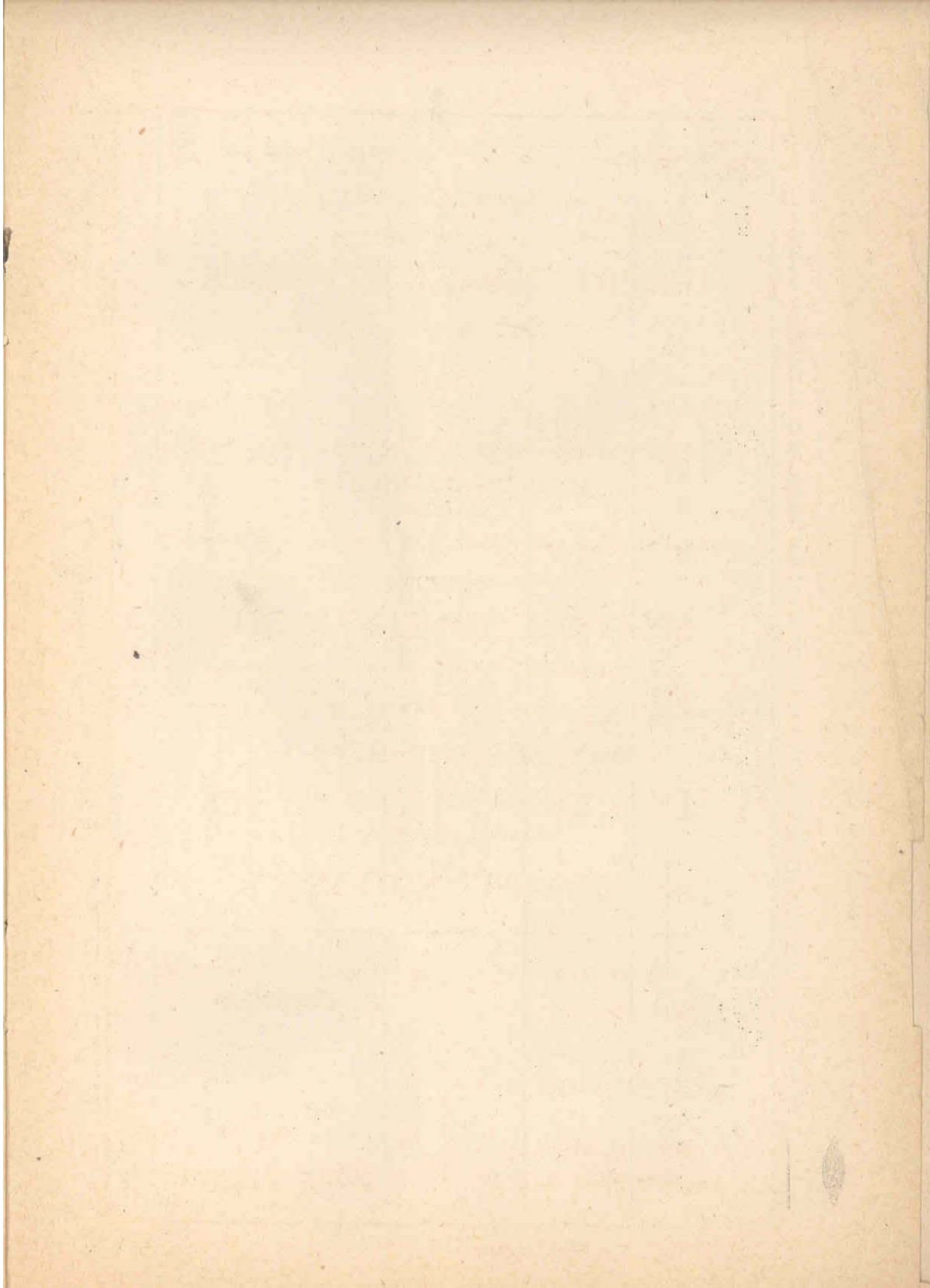

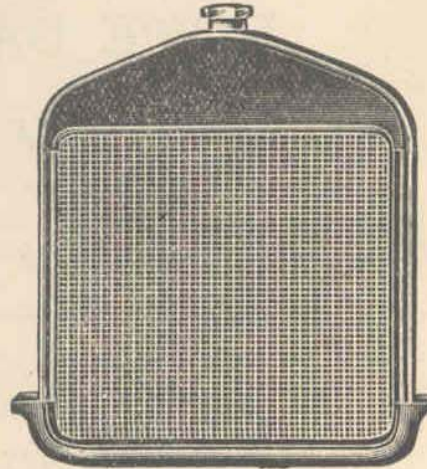
