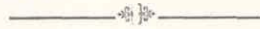

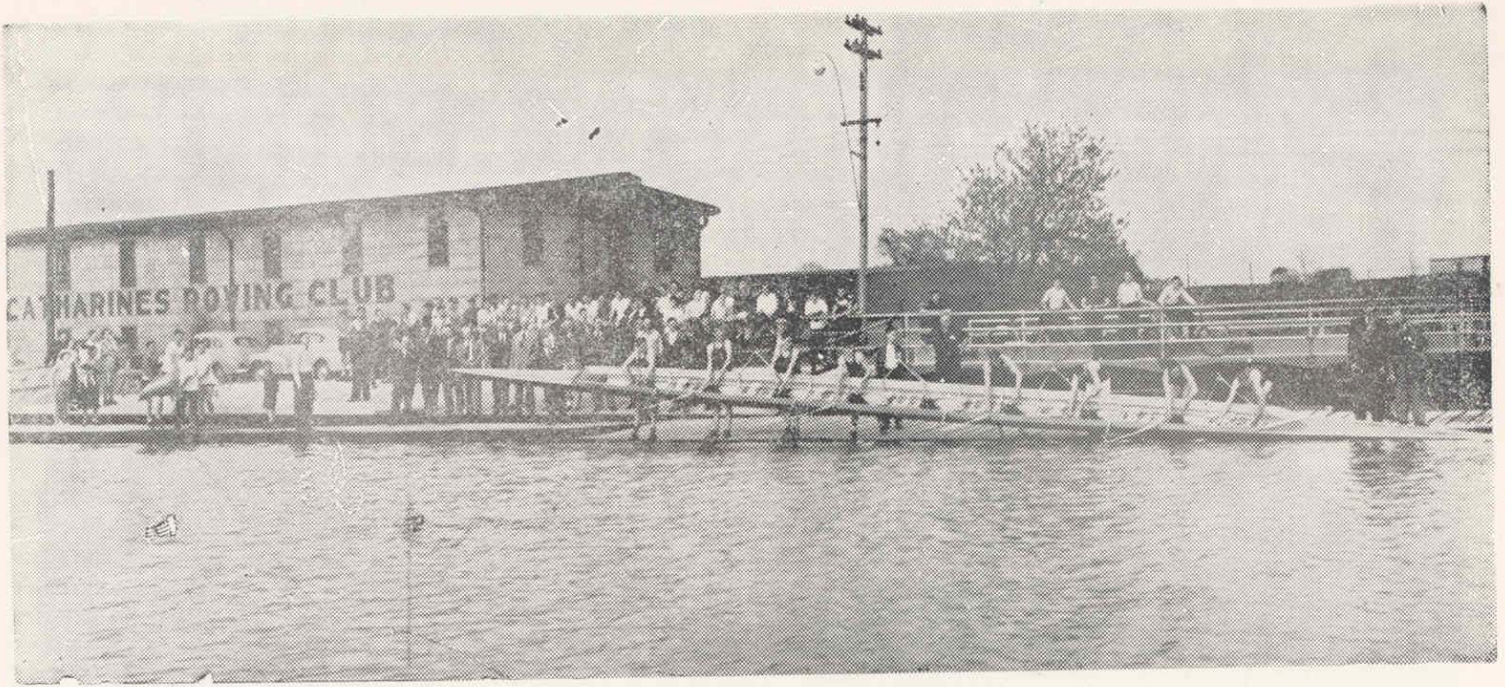

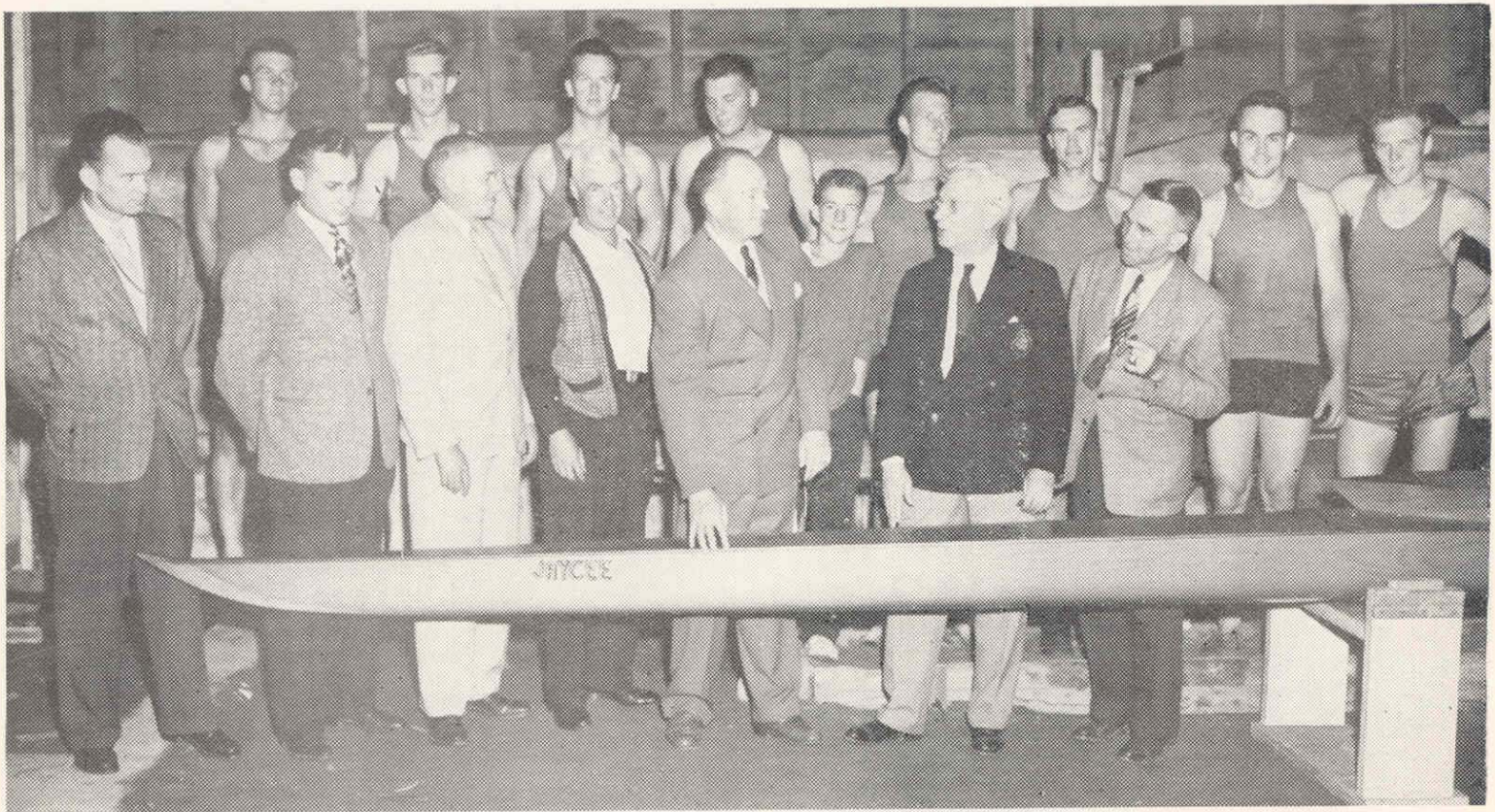


Lions Present St. Catharines Oarsmen With Canada's Finest Shell
